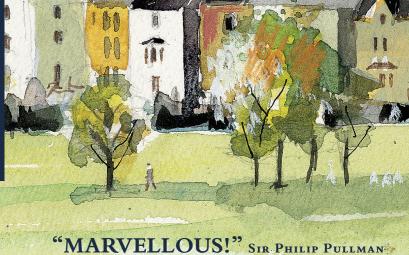

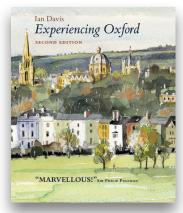

THE AUTHOR

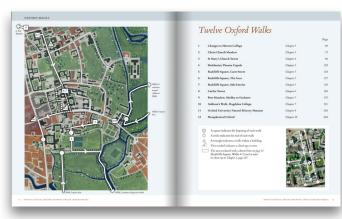
